



GCSE ART Exhibition Set up 2018

Dear parent/student,

As you are aware, we are rapidly approaching the GCSE Art Moderation and Exhibition. It is the responsibility of the students to mount their work in between the 2nd and 6th June, ready for the moderation and **exhibition on 7th June**. The presentation of the work does count towards 'AO4' on the mark scheme and can directly impact their overall grade. Each student will have two panels, one for the coursework project and a second for the exam project. All work must be labelled correctly and loose work/folders must be named. Digital work to be displayed on tablets must be prearranged with the department.

Students may wish to purchase frames, large A2+ prints, sticky fixers or other specialist mounting materials beforehand. Looking at the exam timetable, there will be several times when students are already in school for exams so it may be convenient for them to stay to set up afterwards. Please be aware that extra pressure will be put upon the printing facilities and staff/helpers at these busy times.
